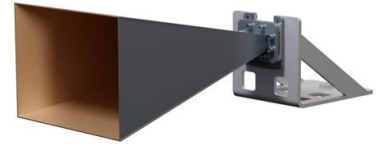

The PE2WAN159-20SF standard gain horn antenna (also known as waveguide horn) from Pasternack is part of our comprehensive selection of waveguide antennas. This standard gain horn is mated with a WR-159 to SMA female waveguide to coaxial adapter and operates from 4.9 GHz to 7.05 GHz.

Our PE2WAN159-20SF standard gain horn antenna with pre-installed L mount has a nominal gain of 20 dBi with a Horizontal and Vertical HPBW (Half Power Beam Width) of 17.5 and 17.3 degrees respectively. Pasternack's SMA female to WR-159 standard gain horns are available in 10, 15 and 20 dBi models with pyramidal shape and connectorized input.

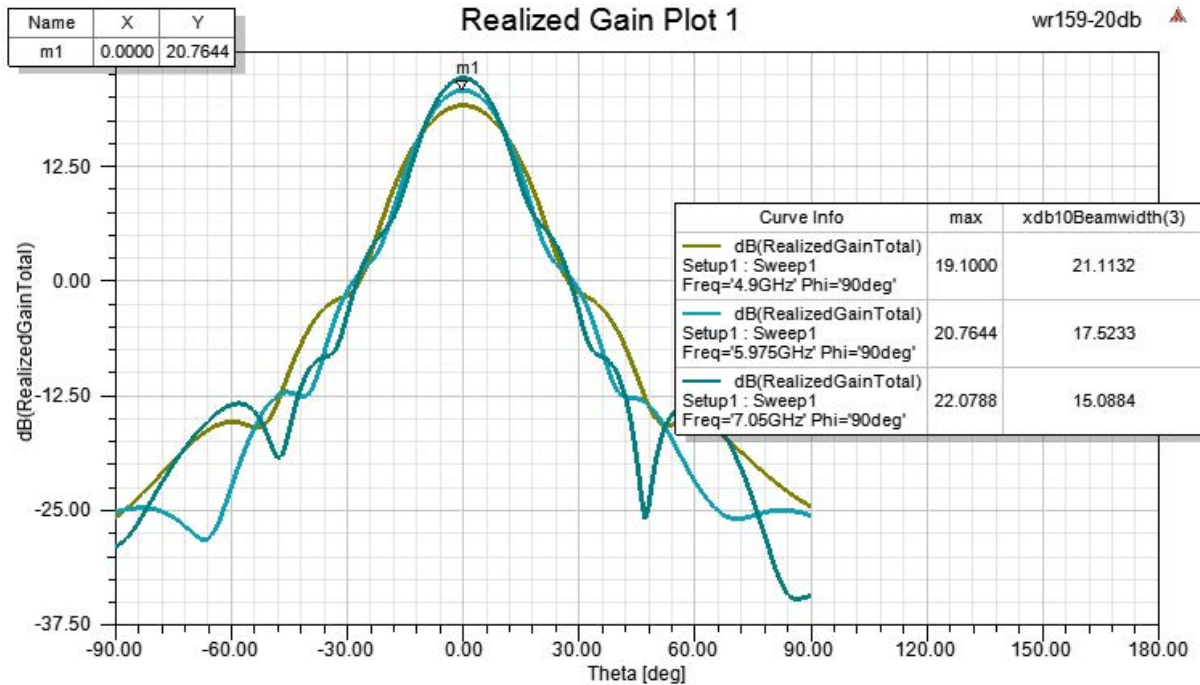
